Mark 11:1-11

- **The geographic location of the journey** (verse 1)
 - at Bethphage and Bethany near the Mount of Olives
 - Very familiar territory to Jesus (John 2:13; John 5:1; John 7:10; Luke 10:38-42)
 - Questions of application:

- **The disciples were with Jesus on the journey** (verse 1)
 - Spent 3 years learning from Him. They watched what Jesus did and were in process of learning how to do the things He did!
 - Questions of application:

- **Jesus was prepared for the journey and invited others to be part of it** (verses 2-7)
 - A colt was ready for the disciples
 - Jesus told two disciples to “go”
 - Questions/thoughts of application:

- **Jesus knew His purpose for the journey** (verses 8-10)
 - Publicly recognized as King (Zech. 9:9)
 - Worshipped by others (Psalm 118:25-29; Hosea 14:2; Ps. 100:2; Ps. 134:2)
 - Questions/thoughts of application:

- **At the end of the day, His journey led back to Bethany** (verse 11)
 - Back to the area He started
